1. Opening of the meeting

Following the opening of the meeting by Mr. Tamme Roodbergen, the Director of the Netherlands Electrotechnical Committee, Derek Johns commenced the 71st meeting of TC 61.

2. Approval of the agenda 61/2811A/DA

Mr. Johns indicated that it appeared that the requests concerning the timing of discussions on several agenda items could be accommodated. The latest list of tabled documents were circulated and added to the agenda for discussion at the appropriate times during the course of the meeting.

3. Note the confirmation of the minutes of the meeting held in Brisbane - 61/2800A/RM

Inasmuch as no written comments were received concerning corrections to the Brisbane, Australia minutes, they were confirmed as written.

4. Reports of the Chairman, Secretary, ACOS representative and CTL liaison member

a. Chairman's Report 61(Delft/Chairman)2a

During the presentation of his report, the Chairman called the delegates' attention to matters to be discussed under Agenda Item 28, "Any other business".

DECISION: The proposal was not accepted. However, it was agreed that the proposal for 7.15 of Part 1 will be circulated as a DC.

20. 60335-2-105: Particular requirements for multifunction shower cabinets61/2791/DC - Compilation of Comments 61/2838/INF

The results of discussions are recorded in 61/2838A/INF.

DECISION: The proposal was accepted to proceed to CDV modified according to the decisions taken on National Committee comments.

21. Questions of Interpretation

a. Document 61/2820/Q - Compilation of Responses 61/2880/RQ

The results of discussions are recorded in 61/2880A/RQ

Taking into account the responses in 61/2880/RQ, the following answers were confirmed.

Q1. - Yes, the VDR's can fail at short-circuit at end of life and therefore there is a differentiation to accommodate this situation in the Fourth edition.

Q2. - First dash – The interpretation is not correct because they do not have to comply with 61051-1. They only have to be used within the manufacturers specification.

Second dash - Yes, this interpretation is correct.

Q3. - This question is theoretical in terms of standards writing since it refers to the third edition of Part 1 which has been superseded by the fourth edition. For CB certificate purposes the CTL should apply the third edition as written.

b. 61(Delft/NL)4 - The opinion of the NLNC is agreed.

c. 61(Delft/SE)5 - The opinion of the SENC is agreed.

d. 61(Delft/AU)6 - Q1 - The modified periods are applied, but the number of cycles are as specified.
Q2 - The answer is NO. You now apply the maximum ingredients for the modified periods, but for the specified numbers of cycles.

It was agreed to circulate a DC to clarify the wording in 11.7 in accordance with these decisions.

e. 61(Delft/UK)12 - Failure in the diode mode is covered by the fault condition in 19.11.2d.

f. 61(Delft/DK)20 - There is no particular reason for a difference in wording. Refer to edcom for resolution when preparing the FDIS for AM2.

g. 61(Delft/IT)22 - Q1 – The answer to the first part of the question is “Yes”, and to the second part the answer is also “Yes” because temperatures are only measured on the outside surface of the oven door or the guard on the outside of the oven door.

Q2 – The ITNC interpretation is correct.

h. 61(Delft/US)38 - The interpretation of the USNC is correct. The series of three impacts is applied to the sample. In case of doubt concerning the weakest point, a new sample is used for each subsequent series of impacts to the other areas of the device, however if necessary these new samples must also be preconditioned according to the test sequence stated in 5.2.

The report was noted. The work of the PT was discussed under agenda item 7.

23d. Report of Working Groups**WG 27** - Safety of tumble dryers incorporating motor-compressors

No report received, the result of their work is currently circulating as 61/2868/CDV.

SC 61B – Safety of household microwave ovens **[61(Delft/SC 61B)8]**

The report was noted and the Secretary was thanked for the report.

SC 61C – Household appliances for refrigeration **[61(Delft/SC 61C)9]**

The report was noted and the Secretary was thanked for the report. The subcommittee would like to meet in Mexico in 2006 in conjunction with TC61.

SC 61D - Appliances for air-conditioning for household and similar purposes

No report was received, the sub-committee has not met since the last meeting of TC 61.

SC 61E - Safety of electric commercial catering equipment

No report was received, the sub-committee has not met since the last meeting of TC 61.

SC 61F - Safety of hand-held motor-operated electric tools **[61(Delft/SC61F)23]**

The report was noted and the Secretary was thanked for the report. The proposal to consolidate all of the standards under their scope into different parts of the 60745 series was noted.

SC 61H - Safety of electrically-operated farm appliances **[61(Delft/SC61H)10]**

The report was noted and the Secretary was thanked for the report.

SC 61J - Electrical motor-operated cleaning appliances for industrial use **[61(Delft/SC61J)17]**

The report was noted and the Secretary was thanked for the report. Concerning the request for a change to the scope of SC 61J, the decision of TC 61 was as follows:

TC61 agrees with their intent to work on performance and environmental issues, however they must be not be included in their safety standards, but must be separate standards.

It was also noted that according to 61J/173/RM that one O member (CA) and five P members (DK, DE, CH, UK, and US) attended the meeting. The delegate from IT did not attend due to an illness. The total number of P members is twelve, those P members who did not attend were AT, CN, CZ, KR, PT and UA.

Noted – other documents can be added up until mid - June 2005. The final agenda should be released by the end of June.

26. Review of TC 61's Strategic Policy Statement

61/2802/DC - Compilation of Comments 61/2841/INF

The SPS is confirmed subject to inclusion of the changes agreed as detailed in 61/2841A/INF.

28. Any other business**28a. Decisions related to the Chairman's report - 61(Delft/Chairman)2a**

1. Questions detailed in the Chairman report - [61(Delft/Chairman)2a]

Argentina 1: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed.

Australia 1: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed – the proposed changes will be included in the CDV for am 2. Suggest repeating the compliance of 8.1.1 in 8.2.

Brazil 1: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed.

France 1: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed.

France 2: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed.

New Zealand 1: The response in 61(Delft/Chairman)2a was confirmed. In addition, an adhoc group was formed to discuss the matter further. Their deliberations are detailed in 61(Delft/Capacitor AHG) 41. It was agreed that 24.1 needs modification to make it clear that the level of fire hazard assessment in Clause 30.2 applies to all parts of the appliance including connections inside the components. It was also agreed to introduce a requirement for motor run capacitors that they must comply with 2.16 of IEC 60252-1 by failing open-circuit.

CTL 5 (DSH 514) – This construction is not allowed according to the published standard.

CTL 6 (DSH 495A) – All relevant clauses related to insulation properties and their applicability must be taken into account. Giving only a couple of examples may be misleading.

CTL 8 (DSH 484) – The decision sheet was reviewed in conjunction with 26.2 and 26.11 of the fourth edition of Part 1 and it was agreed to circulate a DC containing a proposal to include the fourth dash of the note in 22.31 into 26.2 and 26.11. In the interim, the CTL is requested to revise the decision sheet to refer to Class II constructions rather than Class II appliances.

29. Date and place of the next meetings

The committee has been invited by the South African National committee to meet in Cape Town the week 17 – 21 October 2005 (in conjunction with the IEC general meeting). This was accepted with acclamation.

Invites for future meetings have been received as follows.

- 15 -19 May 2006, Mexico
- 9 -13 October 2006, Korea

We should look to hold at least one of the 2007 meetings in Europe, National committees are asked to consider making an invitation.

30. Close of meeting
